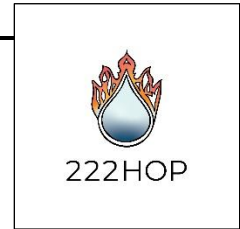

2025 Impact & Highlights



2025 Impact:

- **200+** prayer and worship meetings were hosted.
- **120+** attendees at our summer community concert night.
- **50+** volunteers served at the prayer meetings throughout the year.
- **30+** students were trained in the music school over the course of the year.
- **5** part-time staff onboarded in this year alone.
- **1** 24-hr prayer burn staffed by 20+ people from 5 different ministries.
- **1** international trip to the Middle East.

2025 Ministry Highlights:

- **Leadership Team:** 222HOP is thankful to have seen five (5) part-time staff join the leadership team in 2025. This was a huge development for the ministry and allowed for rapid growth of sets, domestic trips and the music school.
- **Two Domestic Missions Trips:** The 222HOP leadership team led two (2) domestic mission trips to Washington, D.C. to help at a 24/7 worship tent there, and to participate in Communion America.
- **Music School Growth:** The 222HOP Music School developed and grew from just a few private lessons to a twenty-five (25) student, curriculum-guided instruction school. Over the course of the year we had thirty (30) students participate in 2025, learning on eight (8) different instruments.
- **Community Concert Night:** The Christian artist Jess Ray came in July to host a concert at 222HOP, which was a dream come true for some. We had over one hundred twenty seven (127) attendees come to the community concert.
