• **Middle East Trip**: We visited an unreached people group in the Arab Gulf desert and volunteered at a local house of prayer. Two city leaders traveled with us for this special trip.



• **Israel Fast**: We hosted the local meetings of the Isaiah 62 Fast, a global fast for the salvation of the people of Israel. We hosted 21 days straight of nightly meetings. Over 10 churches and ministries were represented in this event.



• **ATD Tent**: We hosted 50 hours of public, outdoor nonstop prayer and worship in a tent. 17 churches and 70+ volunteers supported this wonderful event!
